2. The contracting authority shall not allow a site visit. Further information is given in the tender documents.

3. The contractor group does not need to establish a legal form, but must designate a leader of the contractor group. All members of such a contractor group formed to perform the subject matter of the Contract are required to grant a power of attorney to one of the members of the contractor group to act on behalf of all members of the contractor group and to take instructions in this public procurement, as well as to act on behalf of the group in the event of acceptance of their tender, signing of the Contract, and communication/liability in the process of performance of the Contract. In the event of acceptance of a tender from a group of Contractors, the group of Contractors shall be required, prior to the signature of the Contract, to conclude and submit to the Contracting Authority a Contract which clearly sets out the mutual rights and obligations, who will share what part of the Contract, and that all members of the group of Contractors are jointly and severally liable to the Contracting Authority for their obligations to the Contracting Authority.

A call for tenders shall be deemed to be a call for tenders published in the Public Procurement Bulletin.

Where services other than those covered by the contract have been provided in the context of the list of services submitted, the value of the services covered by the contract must be obvious from the document for an objective assessment of compliance with the conditions of participation.

In case the tenderer submits/claims a contract or a contract whose performance/provision exceeds a specified period of years, i.e. the provision of services started three (3) years ago or has not been completed by the time of the call for tenders (hereinafter also referred to as the 'Relevant Period'), or a contract/purchase order the performance of which started more than three (3) years after the call for tenders, the tenderer shall list separately the prices and volumes for that part of the services provided which were provided within the required Relevant Period.

- information on the legal relationship with the tenderer - if an employee of the tenderer, the job title (current job title) is requested. In the event that the fulfilment of the participation condition is demonstrated by another person, the conditions of § 34(3) of the Public Procurement Act shall apply. In the case of an employee of another person, an indication of the relationship and job title of that person is also required.

The contracting authority reserves the right to verify the accuracy of the data provided.

The contracting authority shall also accept other document(s) of equivalent content and scope for the fulfilment of the conditions of participation proving the required facts. The contracting authority will also accept equivalent document(s) and document(s) issued by other EU Member States.
